








How to Draw a Leprechaun



How to Draw a Leprechau

- Draw a large "u" shape in the middle of the page. It should start and end in the middle of the page.
- Add legs and a rim to the pot.
- Above the middle of the brim draw a small circle. Add the two sides of a bow tie. 3
- Make a "wavy" "U" shape coming up from the bow tie. This will be the leprechauns beard.
- Add "elf" ears to the leprechaun. 5
- Start the hat by drawing a slightly curved line above the beard and ears turn this into 6 an oval.
- Draw a hat above the brim and add a ribbon across.
- Draw a "U" inside of the beard for the leprechauns face. 8
- Add arms to each side by drawing rectangles. q
- Make cuffs by drawing small thing rectangles next to the arms. 10
- Draw hands with 5 fingers on each arm. Make the first and last finger shorter.
- Draw a semi circle for the nose. 12
- Draw two round eyes. 13
- Draw small thin ovals above the eyes to make the leprechaun's eyebrows. 14
- Add a half smile with a line. 15
- Decorate by drawing a rainbow, ground, and some four leaf clovers. Then COLOR! 16
